

BROTHERHOOD SHOP

By way of experiment it is proposed to open a shop in Gertrude St., Fitzroy, on Monday, July 25th. Clothes (new and old), cooking and other such household utensils—in fact, anything that can be sold over the counter to the poor of the district, will be thankfully accepted by the committee responsible for the venture.

Goods addressed to the Brotherhood may be consigned to Flinders Street Railway Station or left either at Brotherhood Headquarters, 65 Brunswick Street, Fitzroy, or at 12 Horsburgh Grove, Armadale.

Those who desire goods to be called for should communicate with Mr. H. L. Tucker at the last-mentioned address (Tel. U 3053).

The shop is to remain open until all the stock is sold and will open again as soon as further stock is available. If the venture is successful it will take the place of the Market Week that was held last year. The shop should not only help the Brotherhood, but it should be a great boon to the people of Fitzroy who are in need of those things that are no longer needed by others.

Jams and other foodstuffs will also be sold.
